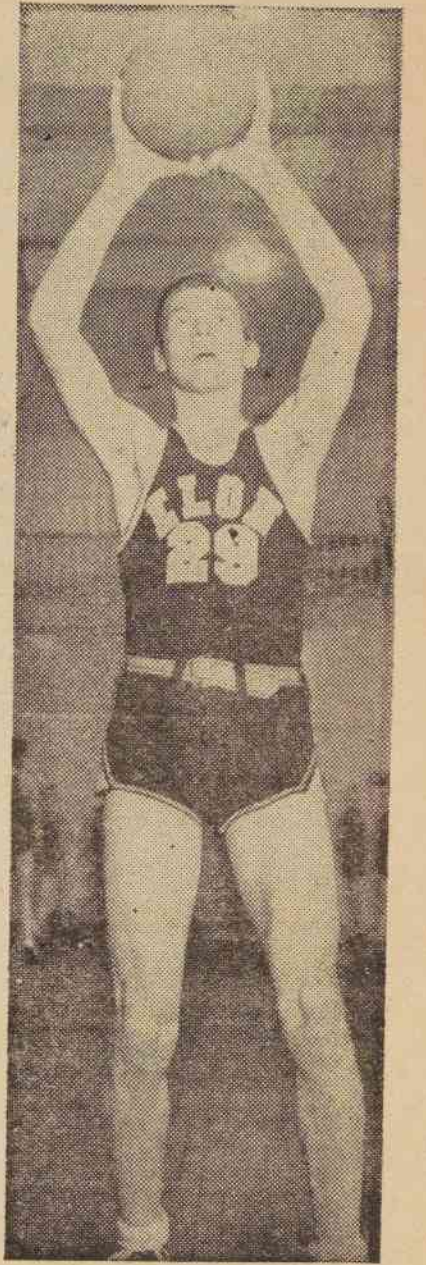

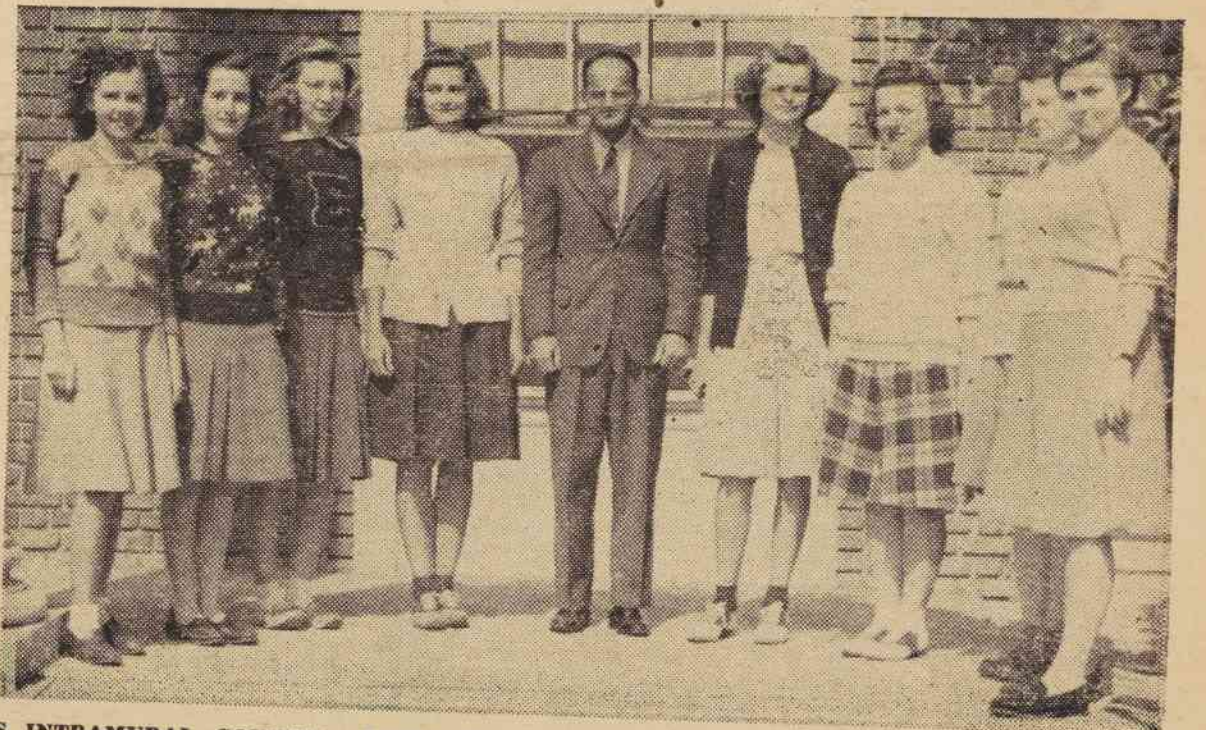
MESSIAH CHORUS, which presented Handel's famous work on December 3, in Whitley Auditorium



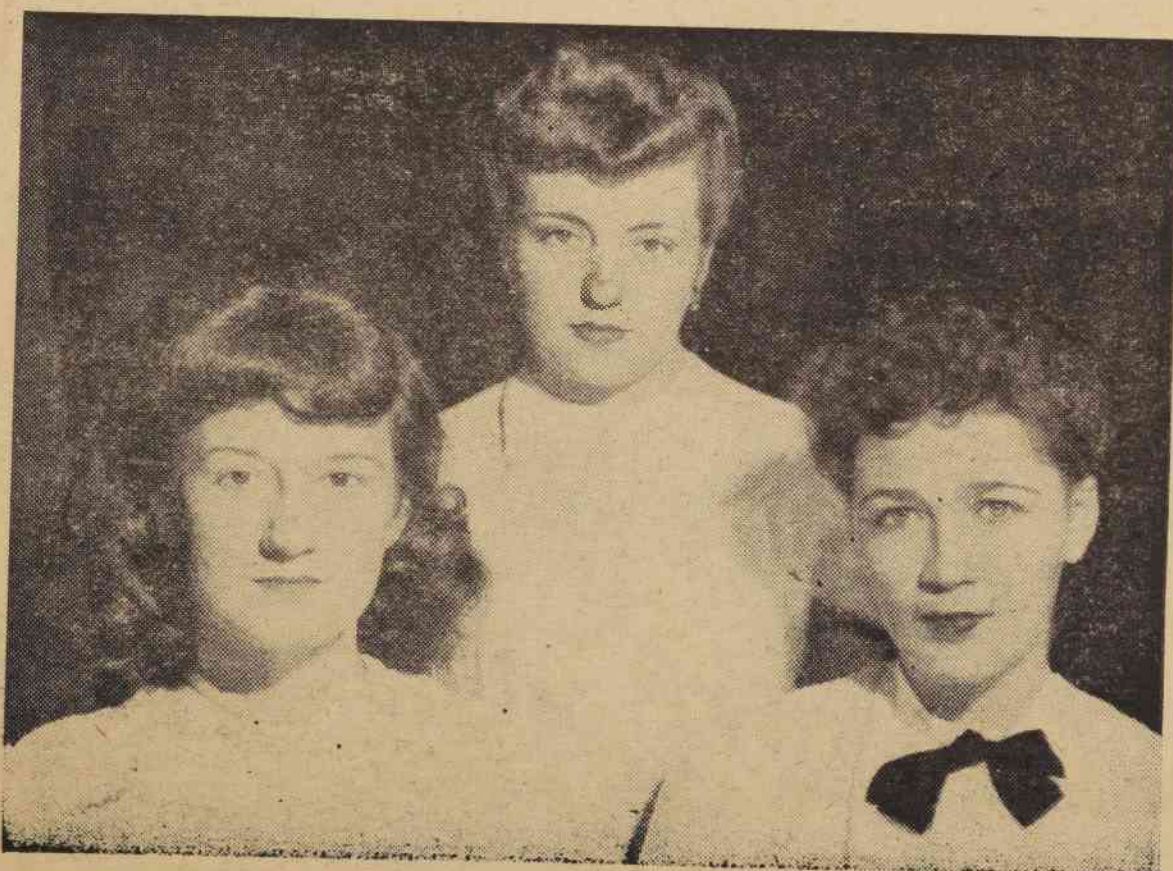
HONEY CATES, Elon's All-Conference center and high scorer.
