Fighting stubbornly all the way, the maroon-jerseyed Elon Christians went down before a powerladen Wofford College eleven by a 14 to 0 count at Spartanburg last Saturday night, but the Christians stayed very much in the ball game until barely five minutes hefore the end when the Terriers counted their second and clinching touchdown.

Playing without the services of Charlie Maldon, Elon's brilliant senior quarterback, who saw not one second of action due to a leg injury that had handicapped him through two earlier games, the Christians yielded one touchdown to the Terriers after 9:30 of play in the first quarter for the 6-0 score and another with ten minutes gone of the final period for the 14-0 find margin.


