Beginning next year, their responsibilities

will include many duties. They must supervise monthly health and safety checks, supervise maintenance of the check-in/check-out process, and supervise room changes throughout the year.

They will coordinate all maintenance requests for the residence area, and will assist in the coverage of the entire area. Each assistant must complete one program per semester, must be available in the Area Office 10 hours each week, and are responsible for duties assigned by the area coordinator.
