

Alan MacLeaod began the band in Paisley, Scotland, with his genius at the bagpipes and was later joined by Roy Gullane, with his guitar backing and vocal skills, and Phil Smith on flute.

Having toured for three years, The Tannahills have performed in more than a dozen countries including Canada and Europe, and have produced five albums to date. It wasn't until their fourth album, however, that the Tannahills were introduced to American audiences in 1981. 
