ROTC students spent summer in training

During the Advanced Camp, the students were trained and evaluated on military subjects taught during the school year, including general military subjects, land navigation, military skills, physical training, tactics, supervision, management and leadership.

During this three week period, the cadets performed the duties of a second lieutenant and received evaluations from active duty colonel.

When asked what the purpose of the Army Reserve Officer's Training Corps program at Elon College was, Captain Jackson replied, "Our ultimate mission is to recruit from

the Elon student population, motivate students to learn, train to Army standards, select and retain quality students, and finally commission the future leadership of the Army."
