## TICKETS

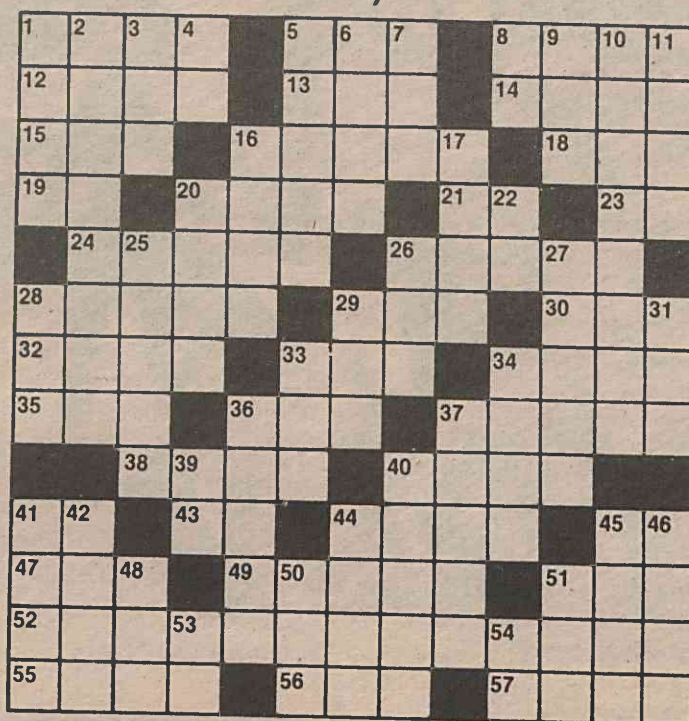

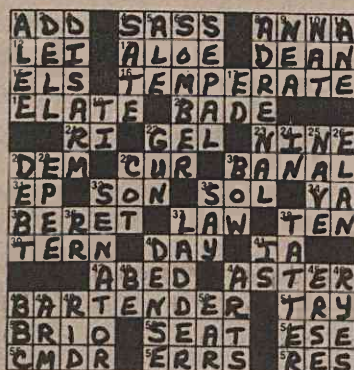
