leges. The Chronicle reports, "In the late 1970's and early 1980's, there seemed to be a tendency on the part of many blacks to feel it was more advantageous to go to a historically white school.

Now some blacks are realizing an education at a historically black school may be more enriching for them." That statement was made by Benny Mayfield, dean of enrollment management at South Carolina State College, a public school.

This brings up another reason why black enrollment is down at Elon. The cost of education is a rising tide that has no thoughts on

subsiding. It is even more difficult to pay for a private college education. Most black institutions, public or private, cost less than traditional white colleges.

With the competition of traditional black colleges attracting minorities, Elon will continue to have low minority enrollment problems.

.667 winning percentage. His team finished 6-4 this year and lost golden opportunity to reach the NAIA playoff round with a closing loss to Mars Hill, 38-0. Carden's teams have failed to reach the playoffs in his tenure at Elon. This could be the reason behind the speculation on campus that Carden, despite his winning record, was forced to resign after this last, lopsided loss. Steve Ballard, the only soccer coach for both men and women teams, also resigned. Most notable among Ballard's accomplishments has been leading the men to successive NAIA District championships in 1987 and 88', and the ad-

vancement of the womens' squad to the Eastern Regionals three years in a row.

In a statement similar to that for Carden, White said, "We are appreciative of Steve and his services to our intercollegiate soccer program and wish him well as he embarks on new career interests."

Ballard indicated that he will pursue opportunities in private business with a local real estate firm. In resigning his position, Ballard said "I have enjoyed my association with Elon College and will miss my friends and the student-athletes I've met. I wish the college, its' personnel, and especially the soccer teams continued success."

A search to fill the positions is already underway.
