### McCutcheon delivers social messages in folk music

John McCutcheon, one of America's most renowned folk musicians, will be performing at Elon's Fine Arts Theatre on Monday, Sept. 9 at 8 p.m.

McCutcheon is a social activist and accomplished instrumentalist. Always a popular Elon favorite, this will be McCutcheon's third concert appearance here in four years.

McCutcheon is well-known for the strong social messages of his songwriting, his storytelling and interactive approach with the audience, and most of all, his mastery of the rare hammer dulcimer.

Professor Anne Cassebaum describes McCutcheon as a "very committed person whose music raises a lot of social issues, yet

includes a lot of humor."

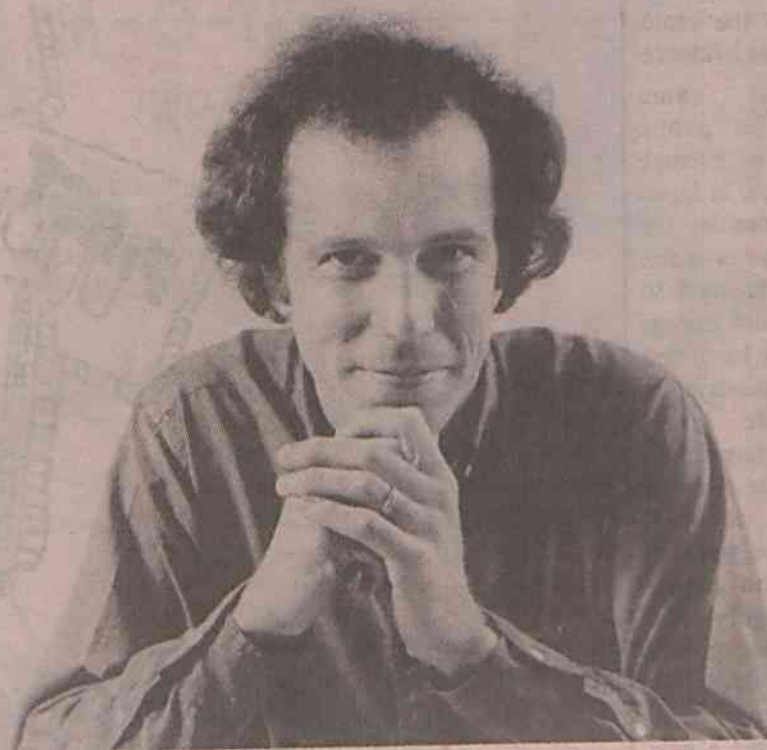
McCutcheon is very popular in speaking and performing because he is "very informal and informative," Cassebaum says.
