

■ A Halloween costume rush party was held Thursday, Oct. 24 at the Zeta House.


Chapter president, Tricia Talbert said about 100 girls were in attendance. All Zeta members were dressed in Halloween attire.

Flasher suspect is arrested

Earlier this week, a Burlington native was convicted of three counts of misdemeanor indecent exposure. One of the three charges dates back to an incident that occurred on the campus of Elon College.

Gary Boyd Moore, 40, a resident of The Economy Lodge in Hillsborough, N.C. was fined \$100 and given a two year suspended sentence for five years.

According to Larry Huger of the Durham County Clerk of Courts office, the sentence is worded so that Moore will receive a two year jail term if he breaks another law within the next five years.
