Freshman killed in car accident

The Elon College police department believes alcohol and excessive speed were factors in the accident that took the life of an Elon College freshman.

Chad Edward Macy, 18, from Pompano Beach, Florida died early Sunday morning as a result of a massive head trauma incurred from a single car accident on West Trollinger Avenue.

"We will receive the blood alcohol content report from the medical examiners office at the start of the week," said Dan Ingle, chief of the Elon College Police Department. "This is the first student fatality (Alcohol - Related) that I recall since I have been here."

According to police reports, the accident occurred at 2:30 a.m. while Macy and Barrett Frain were traveling west on West Trollinger Ave. The car ran off the right side of the road and overturned. It came See Accident, Page 4


