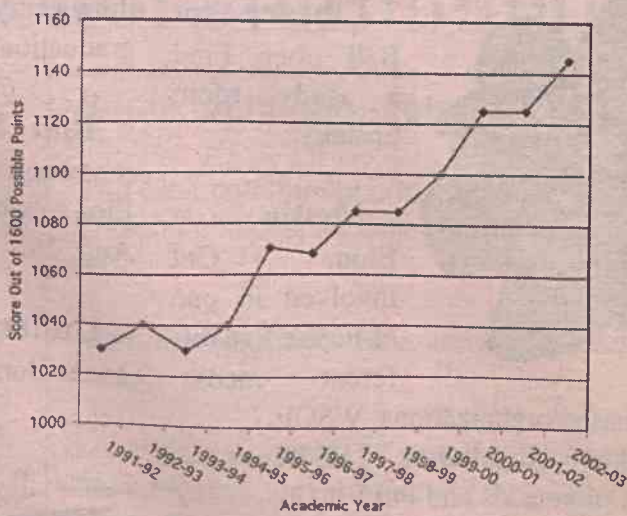
"The students are academically gifted and their extracurriculars bring something to Elon," Powell said.
