A ballet dancer from Morocco performed. Dancing took place in the Zone before festivities moved to McKinnon Hall, where dancers taught salsa and meringue moves.

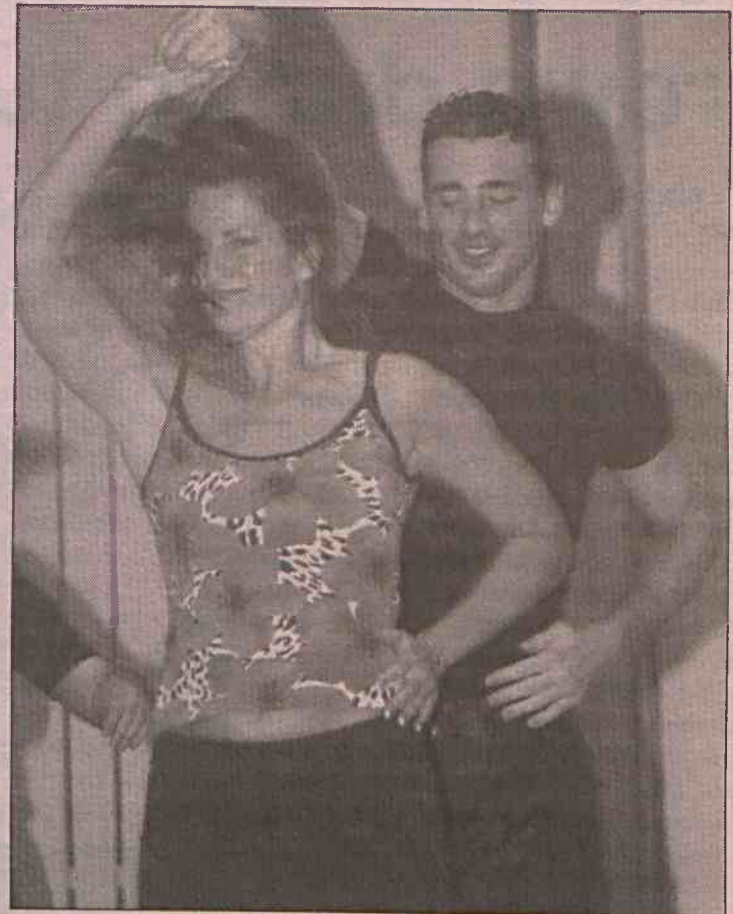
Then Intercultural Relations Club held a fashion show exhibiting fashion from Vietnam and Thailand.

West End Mambo, a Latin music band, say how they are

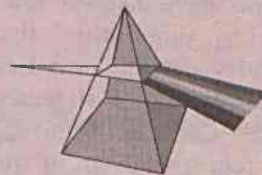
