

*Any person requesting equipment for every class period during a semester will only be allowed to make reservations one month in advance.

Two-Day Equipment

Equipment cannot be reserved. Availability is based on a first come, first serve basis. Film Projectors, Overhead Projector, Slide Projectors, Opaque Projectors, Portable Projection Screen, Record Players, Tape Players, TV/VCR, Cassette Records, Boom Boxes, Flip Chart, Microphones, Powermates, Easels (class period only) and a Portable PA.

The late fee is \$0.50 per day for EACH piece of equipment until the equipment is returned. If a student owes a fine, under no circumstances is he or she allowed to check out other equipment.
