

Spanking: Disciplinary tactic or abuse?

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North Carolina Civil Code says, "It is unlawful for a person to use physical force by other than accidental means creating a substantial risk of serious physical injury to another. Non-accidental force and contact or grossly inappropriate procedures or devices..."

Does spanking fall under the law? "Non-accidental force" means physical force. But marks on the buttocks may fall under that category.
