

Summer construction: Blueprint of Elon



Greek Houses

Five new houses are constructed in Loy Center to provide housing and meeting spaces for sororities and fraternities. Four of the five houses will hold 10 to 13 people and include two single bedrooms. The other building will be split into two 4 to 5 person half houses in hopes of encouraging smaller organizations, such as the National Pan-Hellenic Council, to have a presence in the Loy Center.

Francis Center new playing fields (baseball and softball).

New intramural and club sports playing fields will be created adjacent to the Francis Center. The playing fields will be connected to the road that will join the Danieley Center with the Francis Center.

Road from Francis Center to Danieley Center

A sidewalk will be constructed from Francis Center to Danieley Center to better incorporate the new School of Health Sciences into campus. The project is a three partner project with the Town of Elon, the university and the North Carolina Department of Transportation.

Koury Gym locker renovation plus Recreation expansion

Phase two of the Alumni Gym includes new locker rooms, team meeting rooms and office space for men's and women's basketball and volleyball. The Koury Center will also expand to include the space designated for athletics when the new athletics training and weight training facilities will be located in the Alumni Field House.

Admissions Center Renovation in Moseley

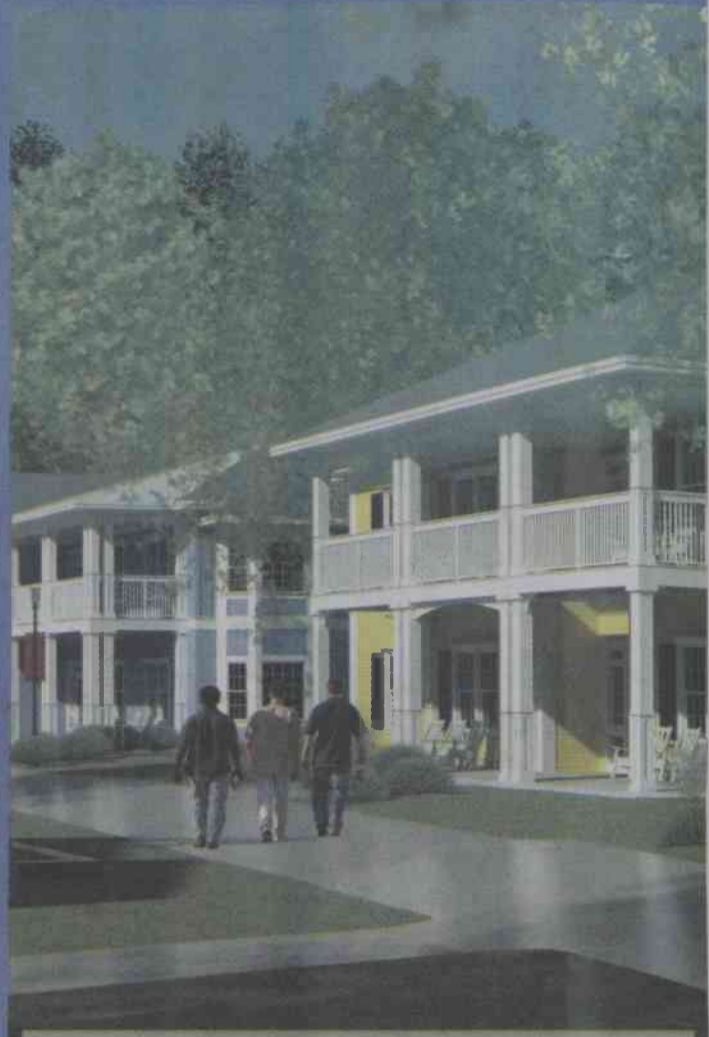
Renovations have begun on the admissions center in Moseley and are predicted to be completed June 10. The aim of the renovation is to make the reception area more attractive, according to Neil Bromilow, director of planning, design and construction management. Changes include new chairs, a new paint job and new carpet.

West Parlor Renovation:

The renovation of West Parlor contributes to the development of Elon's Historic Neighborhoods, which contains former east and west area. Six other designated areas will be part of the residential college neighborhood concept: Colonnades, Global Neighborhood, Danieley Neighborhood, Loy Center, Oaks Apartments and senior class housing. Changes specific to the Historic Neighborhood include additional social and academic common spaces.

Williamson Avenue Parking Lot

A parking lot will be constructed this summer on Williamson Avenue and Phoenix Drive, near the future softball field. The parking lot is included in the campus master plan and will provide additional parking once the field is completed. The lot will contain 287 parking spaces.

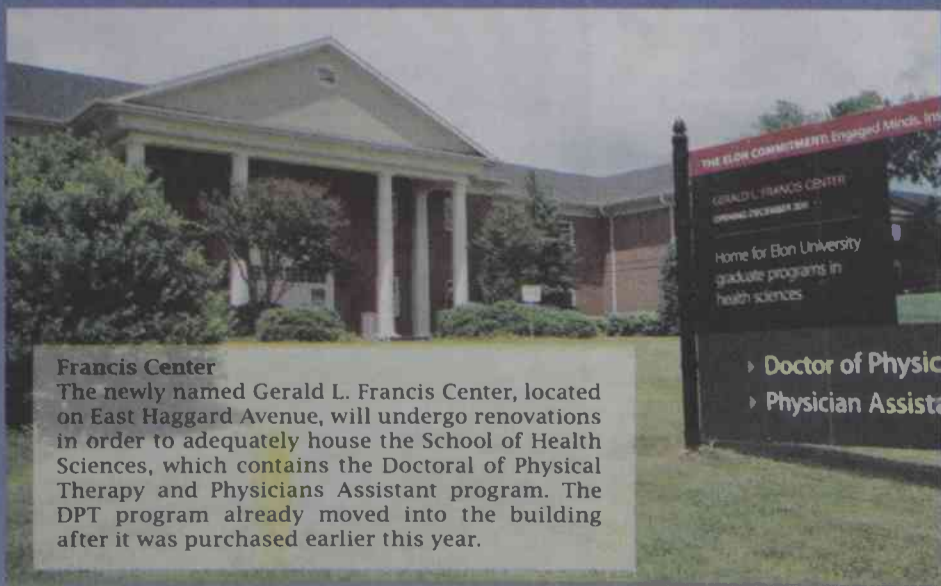


Station at Mill Point Housing

The Station at Mill Point, located at Fire Station Fields, will serve as a new residential community at Elon University, specifically designated for upperclassman. The facility will contain 25 buildings and house up to 324 students. A building will have either two four-person apartments or four four-bedroom apartments. All apartments will come furnished and include a kitchen, a dining area, a living space, a washer and a dryer.

Colonnades CDE and Geothermal system

Colonnades CDE will be constructed behind Koury Business Center. The new facility will contain single rooms as well as four-person suites, common rooms, common kitchens and study rooms. Colonnades CDE will collectively house 300 students. These houses, in addition to the Colonnades Dining Hall, will have solar panels in hopes of reducing carbon dioxide emission and the demand for gas and electricity. The heating and cooling system will be tested May.



Francis Center

The newly named Gerald L. Francis Center, located on East Haggard Avenue, will undergo renovations in order to adequately house the School of Health Sciences, which contains the Doctoral of Physical Therapy and Physicians Assistant program. The DPT program already moved into the building after it was purchased earlier this year.
