Families and guests should be seated by this time.

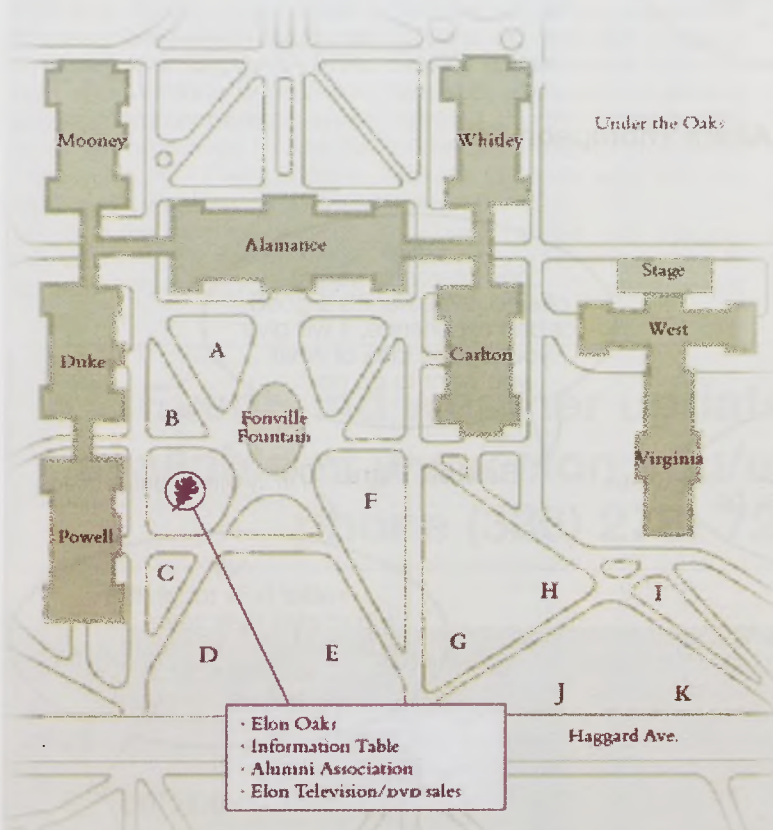
Elon University 122nd Commencement
