During the ceremony, the Salvation Army band also performed and was accompanied by Christmas carolers. This time of season encompassed several religious holidays, Elon's Hillel group acknowledged the upcoming celebration of Hanukkah by lighting the Menorah and offering a Jewish prayer. Following the prayer, then-chaplain Richar McBride promised the children a special guest from the North Pole

"We all will get to be children once again and enjoy the season," McBride said. Now better known as the Festival

of Holiday Lights, Elon has recognized its generous alumni and senior student donors by adding their names on each of the luminar ias, which now total more than 3,000 in the university's fifth year celebrating the holidays in this way.
