ENTERING 100TH YEAR

FSU FACULTY CONFAB SET FOR AUGUST 12 AND NEW STUDENTS ARRIVE AUGUST 14

The theme for the Fayetteville State University centennial is "One Hundred Years of Academic Excellence: A Past to Remember, A Present to Behold, A Future to Mold."

And with this theme, FSU will move into its 100th year of operation when University Chancellor Charles "A" Lyons, Jr., addresses the opening fall faculty conference August 12 with freshmen and new students scheduled to arrive August 14. FSU, the second-oldest

state supported institution (founded in 1877), will celebrate its centennial year during the 1976-77 academic year and the fall faculty-staff conference will highlight the opening of the new year.

The four-day confab, which will be presided by Dr. Defield Holmes, Provost and Vice-Chancellor for Academic Affairs at FSU, will include introductions of new faculty and staff members, departmental meetings, and a faculty-staff dinner in the H.L. Cook Dining Hall.


