All the students elected were from the College Transfer divisions.

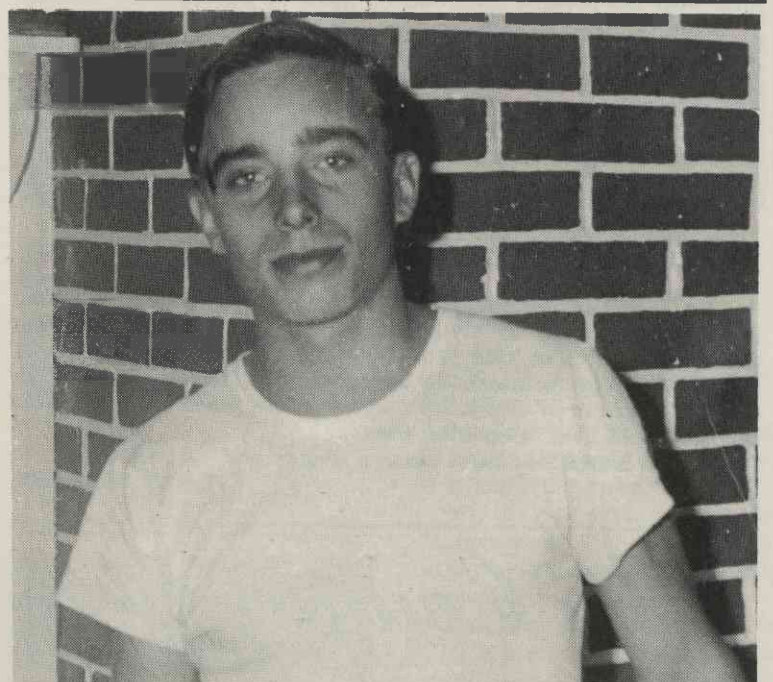
There were no candidates from the vocational or technical divisions.
