## RECIPE OF THE MONTH <br> 12 in. Monster Cookie

$1 / 2$ cup ( 1 stick) unsalted butter
1/4 cup vegetable shortening
$1 / 2$ cup (packed) light brown sugar
1/2 cup granulated sugar
2 eggs
2 teaspoons vanilla extract
1-1/2 cups all purpose flour
1/2 tsp. baking soda
1/2 tsp. baking powder
1/2 tsp. salt
2 cups (12 ounce pack) -
Semisweet Chocolate Chips
Step \# 1: Cream the butter and shortening together until well blended and soft. Beat the sugars in tum. Add eggs one at a time; then beat in the vanilla.
Step \# 2: sift flour, powder, and baking soda, and salt. Add it all to Step \# 2. Blend well. Add the chocolate chips, but save $1 / 2$ cup. Wrap the dough, chill for 3 hrs.
Step \# 3: Place in a round pan. Add remaining choc. chips on top. Preheat oven to 350
