Interested in working for the Federal Government? Check out the Federal Employment Information System, a newly expanded self-service system offering job information 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. This system makes it easy to obtain daily updated listings of job openings and information on a wide variety of Federal employment topics and programs. You may also request application packages, forms and related materials through the system. Best of all, your use of the system is free, except for the cost of Internet access or a phone call.

Career America Connection. Using this telephone portion of the system, you can explore job vacancies, learn more about application procedures and other employment topics, and request application forms. You may order specific vacancy announcements by fax or mail during your call. Make your career connection by calling the main number (912) 757-3000 or have the factsheet

"Federal Employment Information Systems" (ask for "EI-42") sent to you.

## RECIPE OF THE MONTH

### 12 in. Monster Cookie

1/2 cup (1 stick) unsalted butter  
1/4 cup vegetable shortening  
1/2 cup (packed) light brown sugar  
1/2 cup granulated sugar  
2 eggs  
2 teaspoons vanilla extract  
1-1/2 cups all purpose flour  
1/2 tsp. baking soda  
1/2 tsp. baking powder  
1/2 tsp. salt  
2 cups (12 ounce pack) -  
Semisweet Chocolate Chips

**Step # 1:** Cream the butter and shortening together until well blended and soft. Beat the sugars in turn. Add eggs one at a time; then beat in the vanilla.

**Step # 2:** sift flour, powder, and baking soda, and salt. Add it all to Step # 2. Blend well. Add the chocolate chips, but save 1/2 cup. Wrap the dough, chill for 3 hrs.

**Step # 3:** Place in a round pan. Add remaining choc. chips on top. Preheat oven to 350 F; with oven rack in center. Bake for about 45 minutes.

Makes a 12 inch monster cookie.
