Gingerbread Valentines

- 2 ½ cups flour
- 2 teaspoons cinnamon
- 1 ½ teaspoons ginger
- ½ teaspoons ground cloves
- ¼ teaspoons salt
- ½ cup margarine
- ½ cup packed dark brown sugar
- 1/3 cup dark corn syrup
- 1 large egg



In a large bowl, sift together flour, cinnamon, ginger, cloves, and salt.

Blend together margarine and brown sugar until smooth. Add corn syrup and egg; beat well. Add dry ingredients, about 1/3 at a time, mixing until smooth after each addition. Chill dough one hour.

Roll out dough on lightly floured surface to ¼ inch thickness. Using a heart-shaped cookie cutter, press out cookie shapes or use knife to cut around a pattern. Place hearts on a cookie sheet. Decorate as desired. Bake at 350 degrees for 15-20 minutes until golden. Place on wire rack to cool. Store in
