The speaker gave a brief history of Jerusalem and Palestine, the former Eye, Ear, Nose & Throat home of the Jews. About 125-35 A. D. the uprising of the Jews was most terribly crushed. All the in habitants of Jerusalem were annihilat ed and the city renamed. Until fairly recent times the Jews have not been treated with due respect in Jerusalem. The modern movenment back to the city began about 1880. "How ever," continued Dr. Grant. "the ambition to plant a Jewish colony or plan home for the Jews was brought about by the mob treatment of the Jews in Russia and other countires. Following his summary of the early Jewish history, Dr. Grant entered into the position and relationship of the Jews with the Arabic peoples. Although the total Jewish population is rather small, compared with other nations, they have appeared in most peace conferences held in various countries of the world. "Coolidge is unsusceptible of inflation," began Dr. Grant, "He has held nineteen elective offices of the twenty for which he has been a candidate."




