OTHER SPORTS ON THE WAY

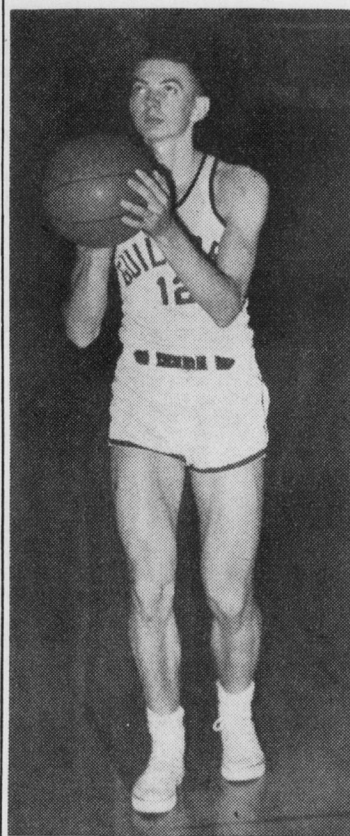
And don't forget the other sports that come to the Guilford campus. Within a few weeks, probably by the first of March, baseball, track, tennis, and golf will start practice.

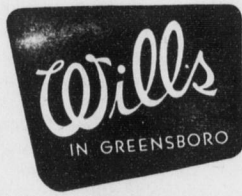
