Women's Basketball

Women's basketball sensation senior Arden Miller has been chosen as one of ten finalists for the Jostens Trophy, an annual award given out to the top player of the year in Division III basketball.

Finalists for the Jostens Trophy receive nomination from a national selection committee. The committee membership includes college coaches, former athletes, college administrators, and selected members of the media.

Criteria for the top award include basketball ability, academic ability, and community

Miller just wrapped up her final season as a Quaker, posting back-to-back doubledoubles in the first two rounds of the NCAA Division III tournament, her eighth and ninth for the season respectfully.

Miller also received second team All-Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) honors alongside Quaker team captain junior Erin Beacham at the league's annual awards banquet during tournament festivities in Salem, Va., in late February.
