



## New Dining Room Unveiled

Mr. Roy Campbell, secretary of the faculty, announced today that Corrin Refectory will be used for a faculty recreation center. Consequently the Day Students Center has been renovated to replace the dining room as an eating place for the students.

Though the Day Students Center is not considered adequate to seat all girls at one time, Mrs. Cummings has announced that meals will be served twice a day in two shifts: brunch will be served at 5:00 A. M. and 6:00 A. M. and mid-afternoon snack at 4:00 and 5:00. Girls who have classes at these times will either have to take cuts or eat at Welfare's or Gooch's but no money can be refunded for board paid at the beginning of the semester.

This action was taken as a re-

sult of a faculty petition for a leisure time center. The Refectory will be re-furnished with ping-pong tables, checkers, chess, bowling alleys, and foot racing hurdles for the faculty.
