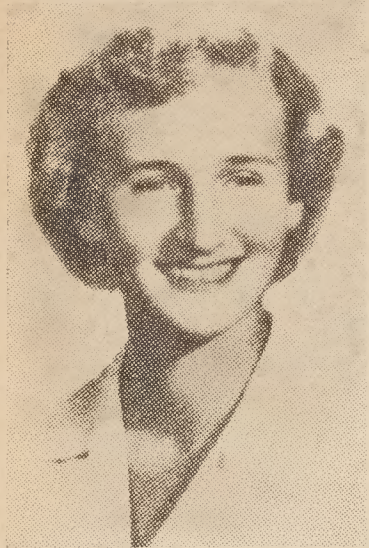


### Betty Morrison Wins Tennis Singles In Play Day At Greensboro College
