The Methodist students at Bowman Gray entertained Salem's Methodist students at a picnic Wednesday night at Miller's Park.

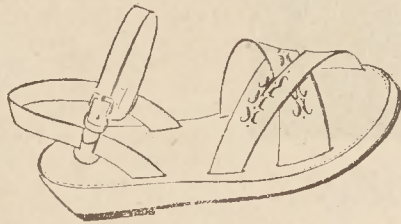

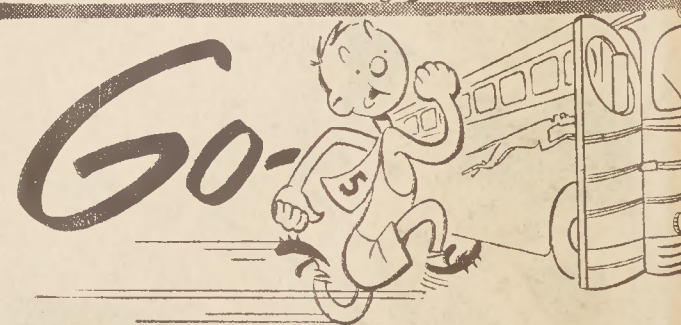
