

Gramley Cites Ogburn Chosen Campus Needs

The Salem Academy and College Board of Trustees has authorized preparation of a long-term campus development program. The campus needs were cited by Dr. Dale H. Gramley in a recent trustee meeting.

Dr. Gramley proposed a program calling for a capital funds campaign to make possible construction of a new college dormitory to house 75 girls, a new college power plant, and an annex to the academy.

Dr. Gramley said his proposal for expansion of facilities does not mean Salem aspires to become a larger college but a better one. A resident student body larger than the present one is essential for more efficient and economical operation, he explained.
