## Art News

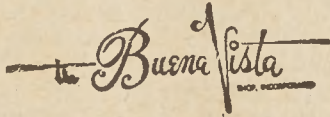
Mr. Edwin Shewmake, head of the Art Department announces a new exhibit by Kenneth Ness which is on display in Music Hall.

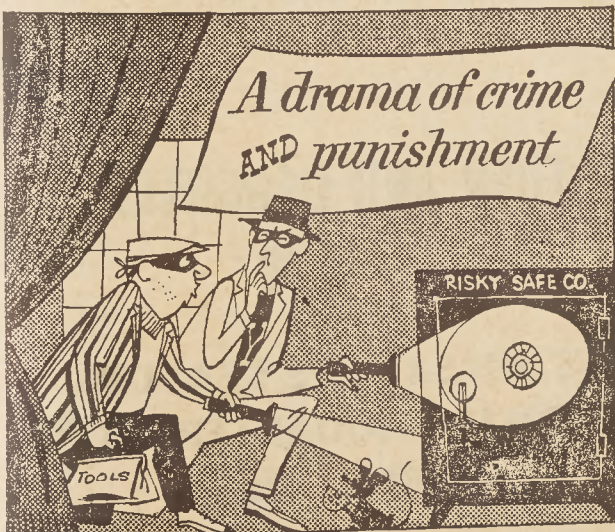
