# Wake Forest Introduces 26 Experimental Courses

The first Experimental College held on the Wake Forest University campus registered into 26 courses students and faculty from Wake Forest University, Salem College, Winston-Salem State College, and the North Carolina School of the Performing Arts.

Seminars were offered in such varied fields as skiing, sailing, karate, painting, psychedelic drugs, prejudice, the thought of Paul Tillich, and cancer. A maximum of twenty students per class limited the enrollment.

The Experimental College is not formally affiliated with Wake Forest University, although it is sponsored by the Student Government and has many faculty participants. The college is based on the idea that knowledge should come from

an interest in the subject rather than grade points and is therefore a testing ground for new teaching methods.

Classes began the week of February 5 and will last from six to eight weeks. Class leadership is under the direction of either co-ordinators who are most often students and senior participants who are experts in their field or instructors participating in non-academic courses.

The only other college of this type is that which is held at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. The college in Chapel Hill is in its third session and offers 54 courses not only to students and faculty as does the Wake Forest college but also to the townspeople.

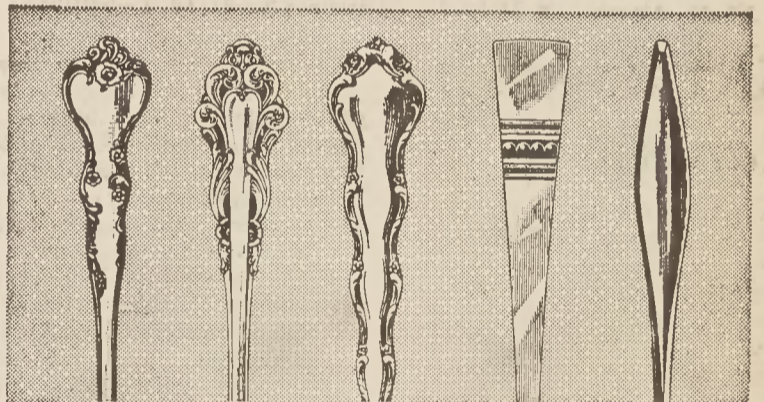

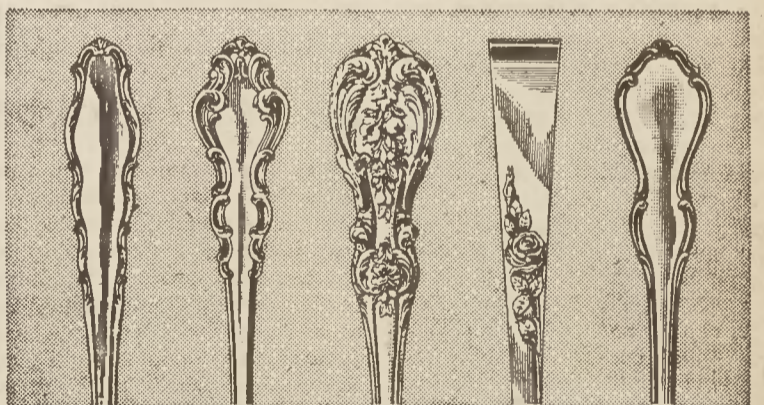
