I think is poor and antiquated. I realize that a change was made this year in the scheduling of exams to prevent a student from having three exams in a row, but this is not enough. Many of my friends and I myself have our two worst exams on the same day. Another scheduling fault seems to be that many people have all their exams bunched together either in the first four or the last four days of exams, with the rest of the time free. It is not worth it to me to finish exams early if I am going to do poorly on all of them, nor to have four days in which to agonize over how much time should be spent studying for each exam.

The biggest fault of the exam system as Salem is that any exam change must be cleared through the office. This is supremely unfair. I maintain that the matter of when an exam is taken is solely between the student and her professor, and is not the business of the administration. Ideally, the student should be able to arrange her own exam schedule so that she may use her time to the best advantage.

I hope that the student body will read and consider this proposal carefully, and will support a petition to this effect which I intend to write.
