Parents' Weekend

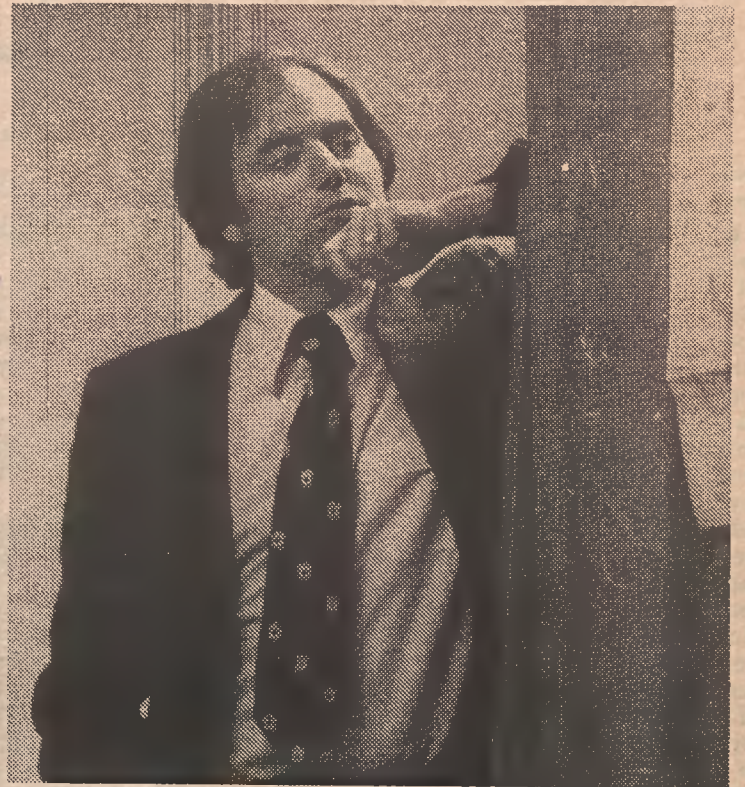

1200 college students from the U.S., Canada and Puerto Rico will participate in the simulated U.N. sessions April 6-11, 1982. The conference will be held at the Grand Hyatt, New York City.
