Library Adds Equipment

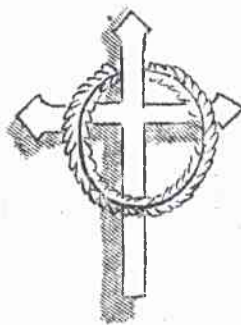
New additions to the school library are a paper-stick for holding the daily paper and another chainpencil to replace the one that disappeared.
