This money is used to defray the Bugle expenses.

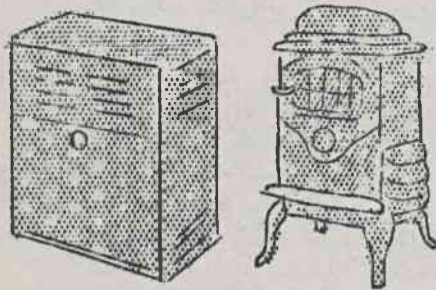

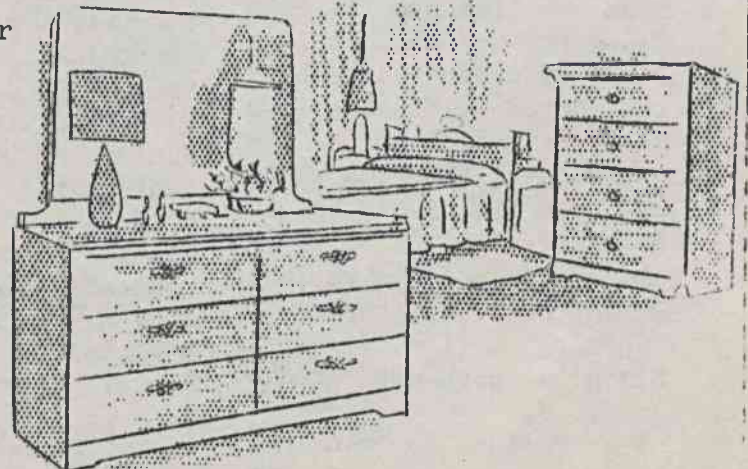
