

Meals Average \$60.69 Per Day In Lunchroom

To feed the Bailey students eating lunch at school, it costs on an average of \$60.69 per day, Mrs. Kermit Lewis's record reveals.

In answer to the question What does a day's lunch cost? Mrs. Lewis has only to refer to the records kept of each day's menu and its resulting prices. The following menu was served October 8, 1953:

- Hamburger and gravy
- Onions and mustard
- Hot rolls
- Garden Peas (with butter)
- Slaw
- Whole milk (plain)
- Doughnuts

The amounts of foods listed for that day with the prices were:

Hamburger, 30 lbs.,	\$12.00
Onions-Mustard.....	2.00
Garden Peas.....	Free
Slaw.....	3.00
Hot rolls.....	11.00
Whole milk(plain)	23.40
Doughnuts.....	<u>9.24</u>

Total \$60.69
Free lunches for this day numbered 23; paid lunches, 377. "This is an average of 400 plates each day" quoted Mrs. Lewis.

ADDED EQUIPMENT

New plastic plates and bowls and new cooking and baking pans have been bought for the lunchroom.

"Plastic plates and bowls were bought because they are light and unbreakable," Mrs. Lewis said.

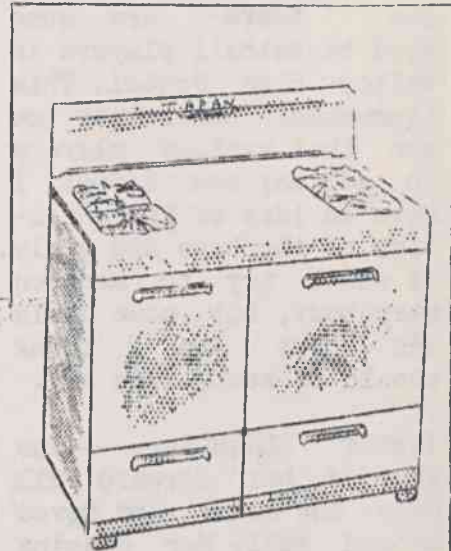
The cost of all added articles was \$491.25.

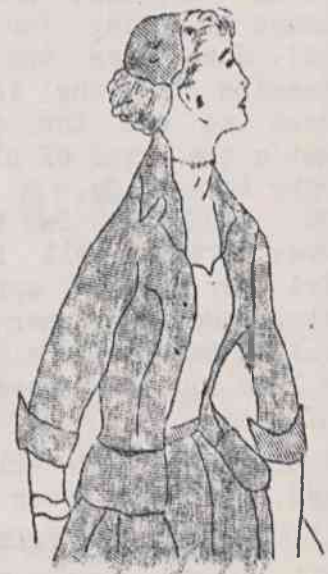
