How much cleaner the grounds are?

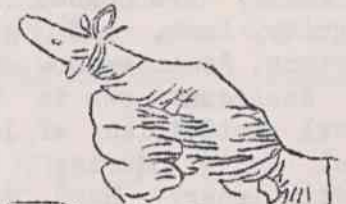
November Birthdays
