

Bus Drivers Travel 227 Miles Daily

Approximately 528 students are transported daily over 227 miles in 9 busses to Mt. Pleasant and Bailey schools. Making up the team of drivers are two girls and seven boys.

"We have to be good-natured," they report.

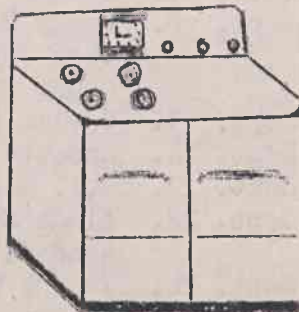
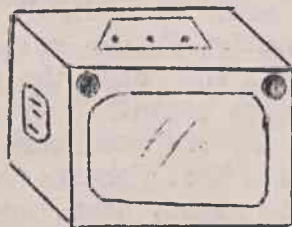
