World Federation Talks Given By Duke Student

Bob Byrd, a student at Duke University, spoke to the English, Sociology and History groups during a recent visit to G. H. S. He has taken a year off from his studies to speak to high school and college students in North Carolina on the need for strengthening the United Nations into a world federal government with limited powers adequate to prevent war and aggression. Byrd's work being sponsored is majoring in Sociology. He is from Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

Since beginning his work in September of this year, Byrd has spoken to more than 1,500 students at 15 colleges and 6 high schools. World federalist chapters have been formed in several of the colleges as a result of this work.

Byrd's work is being sponsored by the United World Federalists of North Carolina, which is a branch of the largest national organization working for the world government. This group is paying his traveling expenses.

In college Byrd was active in the Methodist Student Movement, and was president of the Intercollegiate Council for Religion in Life. His interest in world federation is a result of his activity in the world federalist chapter at Duke. This chapter along with others sponsored the "Washington Caravan" in which students from all over the state went to Washington and talked with the North Carolina Congressional Delegation on world government legislation.

Byrd recently returned from the United World Federalist National convention in Cleveland, Ohio.
