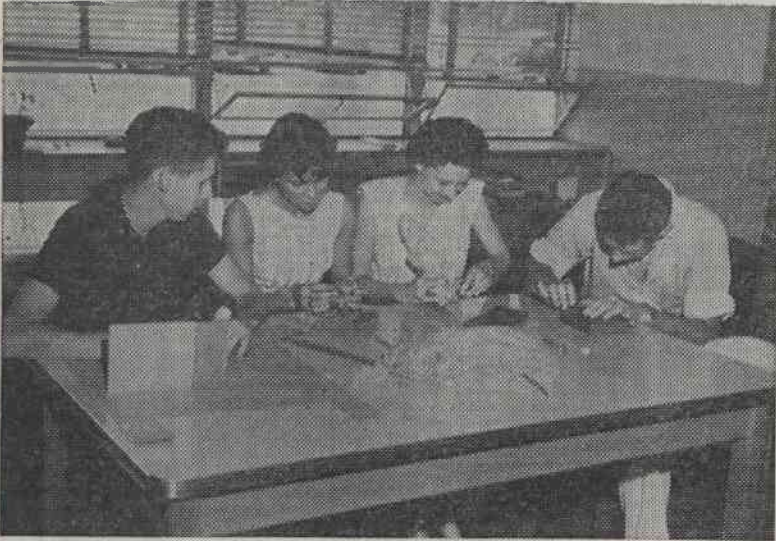

Director Tells How

Art Classes Rotate

"Yes, each year my art course alternates between classical and commercial work," says Miss Laura Boice, art director of the Rocky Mount schools.

"Next year the art course will cover all the graphic arts. This course includes all phases of printing — for an example, linoleum block printing, silk screen stenciling, and stenciling," she continued.

Advertising design, including lettering, layout, and fashion illustration is a section of art work for next year, as is also the study of costume design and ceramics. Ceramic is a study of pottery.

Textile designing and designing in general, interior decorating and theater designing will be studied during the year too.

Miss Boice said that this was not necessarily the order in which the phases of art will be taught, since it depends largely on the group of students, the materials available and the weather.

This year's work consisted of oil painting, water colors, mosaic, sculpturing, working with clay, marble, and last, but not least,

architecture.

Architecture work was the highlight of the year. This section included drawing floor plans, making cardboard house models, and landscaping the yard around the model house. For projects Mike Womble and Richard Taylor designed 'simple' beach cottages. Linda Carol Kelly and Jo-Jo Cuthrell planned modern houses, to name just a few of the types of houses designed and made in the students.
