There are more young people entering the job seeking market than there are suitable jobs".

Many graduating High School Seniors, and college students are wisely following the advice of education experts by planning to take a year off from the academic treadmill to stretch the mind by working and travelling.

Jobs Europe is a program designed to give young people, 18 to 29 years of age, an inexpensive and unique opportunity to live in, and learn about, Europe. In the past 13 years jobs have been found in Europe for 10,823 young people. Three thousand jobs are now available anytime of the year - Winter, Spring, Summer, and Fall. Viggo Olsen's Daktar Diplomat Of Bangladesh

Daktar-Diplomat of Bangladesh is the dramatic story of Dr. Viggo B. Olsen's phenomenal surgicaldiplomatic-wartimeadventures – and the bloody birth of Bangladesh

birth of Bangladesh.

Dr. Viggo Olsen is a diplomat of the American Board of Surgery and a fellow of the American College of Surgeons. He was born and raised in Omaha, Nebraska and took premedical studies at Tulane University, New Orleans. He was a graduate at the University of Nebraska College of Medicine, and he was the youngest of four in his class to receive the M.D. degree cum laude. Dr. Olsen declined the opportunity to become sixth in the prestigious Halsted lineage of surgeons and a professor at an early age. Instead, he flew to the other side of the world to serve East Pakistanis in pain. With his collegues, Dr. Olsen founded a hospital in the southern section of East Pakistan's Chittagong District where modern medical care was unknown.

He wrote and published the Muslim Bengali to English Dictionary, the first such pocket dictionary ever printed in the nation.

"The late afternoon sun acted wisely. It slipped through the low-lying clouds and escaped to a safer land beyond the Bay of Bengal. The time had come to face the harsh realities of night which now enveloped blood-drenched Bangladesh."

"'Daktar Sahib! I have terrible news for you -terrible news! The armed bandits are coming tonight to attack you and the hospital. Daktar Sahib, what will you do?'"

"How does a man get himself in a fix like this? Some say that the whole lifetime of a condemned man may pass before his mind's eye in that last minute before he dies I had over an hour to prepare and wait.... In an instant of time my mind vaulted back -- back --"
