Although the Girl's Softball team has only five returning players, Coach Judy Bradshaw is optimistic about the season, and states, "We have a good chance of winning the conference championship."


Coach Bradshaw, in her first years as softball coach at Senior High, will have to rely on a young team predominately made of sophomores to carry her to a possible conference crown.
