The Quill and Scroll Honorary Journalism Society for high school journalists was organized on April 10, 1926 by a group of high school advisers for the purpose of rewarding and encouraging individual achievement in Journalism. Since that time the organization has an estimation of one million members located in both public and private schools throughout the world. Students serving on any school publication such as yearbooks, literary magazines, and newspapers are eligible for membership in the society.

According to the constitution of the Quill and Scroll Society,

members must be chosen from the students in high school who at the time of their election meet the following requirements: (1) they must be of senior or junior classification. (2) they must be in the upper one third of their class in general scholastic standings. (3) they must have done superior work in some phase of Journalism or school publications work. (4) they must be recommended by either the supervisor or the committee governing publications, and (5) they must be approved by the
