Olin fellowships are open to candidates for advanced study in any of the following graduate and professional fields at Washington University: biological and biomedical sciences, the humanities, sciences physical and mathematics, social and behavioral sciences, architecture, business ad-

ministration, engineering, law, medicine, and social work. Any woman graduate of a baccalaureate institution in the U.S. who plans a career in higher education or the professions is eligible to apply.
