Information Sessions. You need to attend and learn how to start and use your placement file in our office. You will receive a packet containing forms and job campaign information. These

sessions are held in the Continuing Education Auditorium in Cate Center and will last for one hour. On September 18, we will begin at 10:00 AM. All of the other sessions are scheduled to begin at 3:30 PM. Hoping to see you there.

After learning all you ever wanted to know about the Career Services Office and completing your placement file, then you will be ready to interview with recruiters on campus. Three recruiters are scheduled to be here this month:

Tuesday, September 19 - Radio Shack (Tandy Corporation). Radio Shack will be interviewing Seniors with majors in business or economics for positions as Manager Trainee.

Thursday, September 28 - Nash County Schools will be interviewing all Senior teaching majors for elementary and secondary public school positions.

Thursday, September 28 - N.C. Home Economics Extension Service will be conducting a group session for junior Home Economics majors from 9:00-9:45 and will be interviewing Senior Home Economics majors from 9:00-12:00.

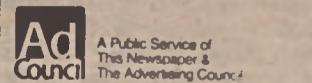
