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Figure 5 shows two ways to wear the girdle. The lower drawing shows a girdle passed twice around togather the loose material around the lady's waist and hips gracefully. Girdles of leather, cord, 2-sided embroidery and ribbon are used. The ends can be weighted with beads. Trim is used lavishly. Bands of embroidery may be sewn at the neck, hemline, sleeves, upper arm sleeve seams, or down the center. Wide bands of contrasting cloth are used similarly (and are cheaper).

Parti-color tunics, divided vertically down the center front and back in 2 colors, are common.
