The New Season of Music, Theater and Dance

The Meredith Performs Concert Series will begin in November with its biggest production of the '85-'86 season, The Sound of Music. It will be followed by Tales of the Jazz Age, The Meredith Dance Theatre, and The Taming of the Shrew.

Tales of the Jazz Age, an original theatre piece, will portray prominent figures: Ernest Hemingway, Dorothy Parker, F. Scott, Zelda Fitzgerald, Gertrude Stein, Isadora Duncan, and Gershwin, recreating the music, dance, and literature of the roaring twenties.

The Dance Theatre, choreographed by Allyson Colwell, will present its show in early April. This innovative creation of modern dance is the result of two semesters of preparation by the

Meredith dancers.

The Taming of the Shrew will be produced with an all female cast. Dr. John Creagh, head of the Theatre Arts Department, is excited about the production and is directing the play from a different angle paroding the sexism in this William Shakespeare comedy. Dr. Creagh also encourages those who do not consider themselves actresses to use other skills: dancers, gymnasts, tumblers, acrobats, ex-cheerleaders, hackey-sack players, clowns, mimes, or those with any unusual skills.

It promises to be a good season and season tickets are available: Adults \$17.00 each, and Students-Sr. citizens \$11.00 each. All are encouraged to attend.

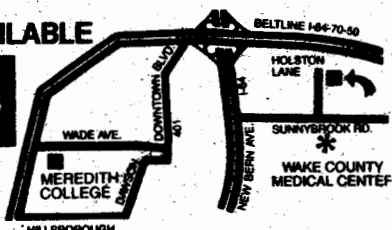
