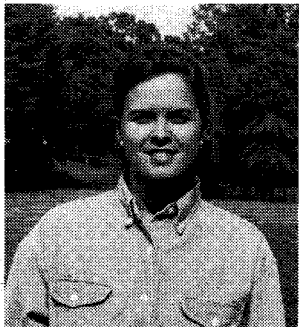


Question of the Week

"I think the uniqueness of Meredith is that it is all women. It would change the whole mission if it weren't co-ed. Meredith is special, so we need to protect its heritage."



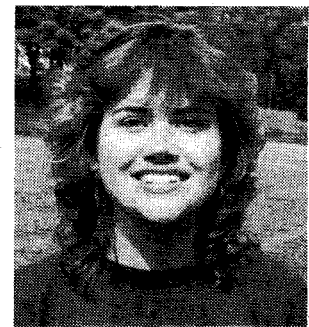
Blythe Taylor
