Orrin Pilkey to speak at Meredith

Prominent geologist Orrin Pilkey will speak at Meredith College on Monday, Sept. 27, 1999, in Jones Auditorium.

Pilkey is a James B. Duke Professor of Geology and the director of the Program for the Study of Developed Shorelines (PSDS), within the Division of Earth and Ocean Sciences at Duke University. PSDS research is focusing on several projects, including beach replenishment and mitigation of hurricane property damage on barriers.

Pilkey also has published more than 200 technical publications and was recently named by the *News and Observer* as one of the "100 Strong, NC Century: People who have shaped our state."
