more than repeat what the book says. I am hoping she will inspire students to take risks and to take responsibility for shaping the communities in which they live," Duncan said.

"I think her story will amaze and excite anyone, whether they've read the book or not," said Chrissie Bumgardner, SRP co-chair.

According to Bumgardner, Nielsen will be available to meet faculty, staff and students at a reception immediately following the convocation. She will also be having lunch with a small group of freshmen, transfer students, and SRP facilitators and committee members.

Nielsen is not the only scientist who will be visiting Meredith as part of the 2002-03 convocation series. On January 24, 2003, Dr. Sylvia Earle, an undersea researcher, children's author and lecturer, will speak. Nancy and Jerry Jaax, the biological researchers who inspired the book and the movie *The Hot Zone*, will speak on February 17, 2003. Both of these convocations will be held at 10 a.m. in Jones Auditorium. Finally, from March 24 to April 5, 2003, Puzzle of Light, a multimedia performance group, will have a residency on campus.
